TECH SCHEDULE FOR 2024 RECITAL 5/29, 5/30, 6/2, 6/3/2024 **PERFORMANCES ON 6/4 and 6/5/2024**

VERY IMPORTANT! THIS ENTIRE WEEK IS MANDATORY IN ORDER TO PERFORM IN THE RECITAL! We have dancers missing at nearly all classes and this is the one time we can count on everyone being there. The stage and costumes makes things feel different, so it is important to have everyone there .

SUNDAY and MONDAY, 6/2 and 6/3 – We are at the THEATER for important Stage and Lighting rehearsals. TUESDAY and WEDNESDAY, 6/4 and 6/5. We are at the THEATER for PERFORMANCES.

1. HIGHLIGHT all your rehearsal times. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to times listed at the theater to allow for traffic and to get settled. Your child’s teachers will go over their specific times at the costume meeting.
2. We are closed for Memorial Day on May 27TH but open Friday and Saturday as usual, May 24 and 25th. **The last day of classes at the studio is Tuesday, May 28. Dress Rehearsals are May 29 and 30 AT THE STUDIO.**
3. If there is an emergency during this week or your child is seriously ill, you must send someone to the studio or theater to speak to the director in person **prior to the rehearsal time.** Dancers who do not show up are removed from show and choreography adjusted. We cannot change choreography back after it has been changed. You must communicate with us prior to the rehearsals if there is a problem.
4. Please make sure the front desk has all phone numbers where you can be reached as we attempt to contact dancers who do not show before we remove them. You may update this info on Jackrabbit.
5. All accounts must be cleared BEFORE MAY 15 or the dancer will not be allowed to perform.
6. **Please do not be late.** Dancers who are late cause a great inconvenience to others who may have made special arrangements to be on time and may have plans to be somewhere afterwards.
7. **DO NOT LEAVE ONCE YOU ARE CHECKED IN!** Technical difficulties beyond our control can cause us to run late or tech dances out of order.
8. For Dress Rehearsal and the Performances, please steam your costume if needed and tack all pieces that need tacking including straps so that over/under straps do not show. We do not steam costumes for you.
9. **Do not drop children off without supervision!** Walk them in and make sure they check in with BC staff. Speak to your child about staying in assigned areas and being respectful to Room Moms, Costume Staff and Student Teachers. Mothers are allowed in the girls’ dressing rooms.
10. No food/drink in auditorium OR dressing areas. Bottled water with cap is allowed.
11. **NO VIDEO OR PHOTOS DURING THE ACTUAL PERFORMANCES!** A professional video and photos are available for sale. See Info our website and the 5 Pointes email for more information.
12. **NO DANCERS IN COSTUME IN AUDIENCE OR LOBBY BEFORE, DURING OR AFTER THE PERFORMANCES.**

Remember.....Recital comes only once a year. We know it can be a busy week, but we hope everyone enjoys this special time with your child!***

Dress Rehearsals are at BALLET CONSERVATORY - Tuesday & Wednesday 5/29 and 5/30:

Dancers will arrive at the studio at the times below wearing their first costume with FULL HAIR AND MAKEUP as it will be for the show. Do not wear your dance shoes outside the building either arriving or leaving. Arrive with a cover up over your costume and head straight to your assigned dressing area for instructions. Bring other costumes organized and labeled. If the costume needs to be steamed, please do this before dress rehearsal.

Label all individual items, especially accessories and both shoes, to avoid confusion in the dressing room. A large zip lock baggie labeled with name and one for each dance with tights and accessories is a great way to organize. Feel free to bring a laundry basket or shopping bag. Dancers will be dismissed after their last dance. **ROOM MOMS – Even though dancers do not wear costumes for the Theater rehearsals, please bring YOUR child’s costume and put on them for lighting purposes. They do not have to have hair or makeup done.**

ROOM MOMS, STUDENT TEACHERS, AND RUNNERS – Please attend all the times your child is attending so Dancers become familiar with you and you learn what to do. There are three Room Mom Meetings at the theater listed below. Please pick one to attend to see where your dressing room is and where to pick up class headpieces, etc.

4:30 pm to 5:00 pm - Class in Studio B for IDC and LBT2 not in Aurora’s Wedding (Clark)

5:00 pm to 5:45 pm –ALL COMPANY FINALE (LBT, LBT2, IDC); I’M JUST KEN.

5:30 pm to 7:30 pm – I Just Want to Be Happy, I Just Want to Join the Circus, I Want to Be A Baker (Ballet), I Don’t Want to Grow Up (Ballet), Kings and Queens (Ballet); **followed by** I Want to Be A Baker (Tap), I Don’t Want to Grow Up (Tap), Kings and Queens (Tap)

Those in Twinkle Ballet/Tap will run their **BALLET** dance and change their shoes and costume and then run their **TAP** dance. Parents just need to make sure they are in their **BALLET** costume when they arrive and leave the labeled shoes and accessories in a labeled bag and then our team will change them for their second dance. We will provide a bag for you to give our Costume Team for their second costume change. We cannot stress enough that each shoe, tutu and accessory be labeled so the right shoes and accessories get back in your bag.

5:30 pm to 6:00 pm - IDC Warmup ONSTAGE (CLARK)

6:00 pm - Check in - All those in Act 1 and those receiving a 5, 10, 15 year award.

6:15 pm - Check in - All those ONLY in Act 2

6:20 pm - Those in 2nd show receiving a 5, 10, 15 Year Award and ALL Seniors line up in the Green Room.

6:30 pm - **SHOW 2 BEGINS!** Awards presented onstage at 6:20 pm. Aurora’s Wedding is 25 minutes long.

***STRIKE immediately following the last performance.** *All Dancers must clean up their own area before leaving. Room Moms are also responsible for straightening their areas before they leave. ALL those in LBT, LBT2, and IDC are required to stay after the 2nd Show to STRIKE (take down drops; pull up Marley, clean dressing rooms, etc.) Parents, especially strong Dads, are much appreciated with the floor. Strike Assignments for each company will be posted backstage. With plenty of help, we should be done in about 45 minutes. Thank you for all your help and commitment this year! We are grateful for our BC Family!*
